Background Information: *Canada officially joined World War II on September 10, 1939, seven days after the United Kingdom and France declared war on Germany. Very quickly Canadian troops were mobilized, and the entire population was encouraged to support the war effort by increasing production, rationing key resources, and supporting the government through the buying of Victory Bonds. In contrast, The United States joined World War II two years later, December 7, 1941, following the Japanese attack on Pearl Harbor.*
