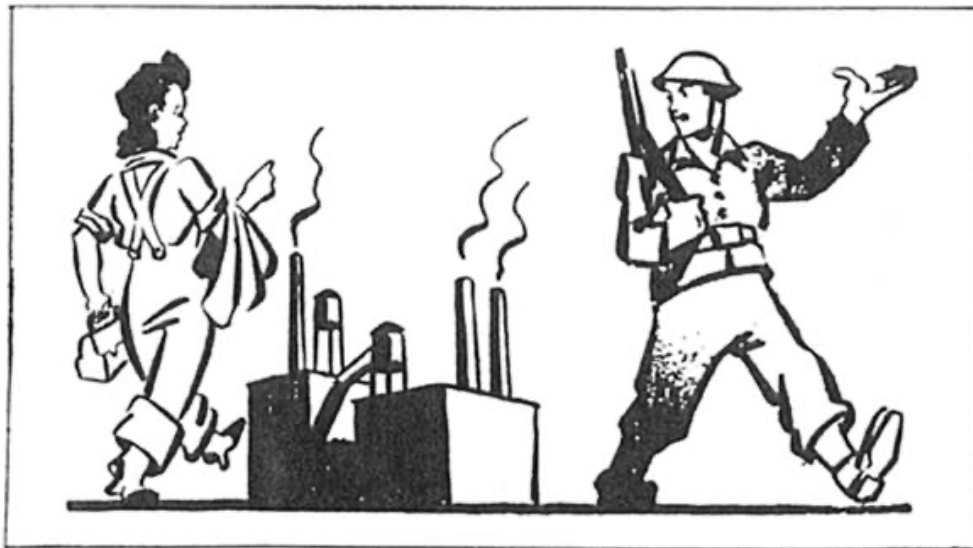




Directions: After reading the background information and examining the source, answer the questions below.
