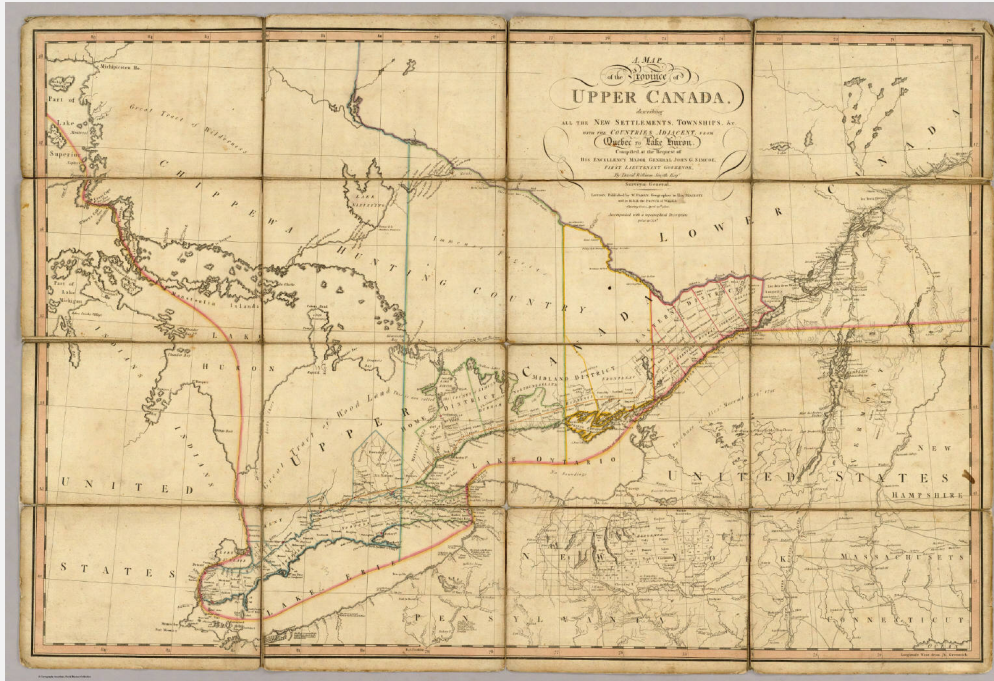




**Directions:** After reading the background information and examining the source, answer the questions below.

**Background Information:** After the Seven Years' War, the Treaty of Paris in 1763 gave the British control of New France. Initially the British instituted the Quebec Act of 1774, which separated New France into Ontario and Quebec, however 17 years later the British passed the Constitutional Act, which divided the colony into Upper Canada (English-speaking) and Lower Canada (French-speaking).
